THE CENTER HELPING OBESITY IN CHILDREN END SUCCESSFULLY, INC. RECEIVES \$25,000 GRANT FROM THE UPS FOUNDATION

Atlanta, GA – September 16, 2016 -- The Center Helping Obesity In Children End Successfully, Inc. (C.H.O.I.C.E.S.) received a \$25,000 grant from The UPS Foundation, which drives global corporate citizenship and philanthropic programs for UPS (NYSE:UPS).

This program uses the We Can! curriculum (Ways to Enhance Children's Activity and Nutrition) developed by the National Institute of Health. This grant is so important to C.H.O.I.C.E.S. because it will create a second location to teach the series thereby, doubling the amount of families that it can currently reach.
